

PRODUCT AUTHENTICITY

Not all brands of rigid conduit in the market perform to the same level. For proof of intended performance, check the mandatory print requirements that are marked on the conduit.

- 2 Designed specifically to protect electrical wiring
- 3 **Classification Rating**
